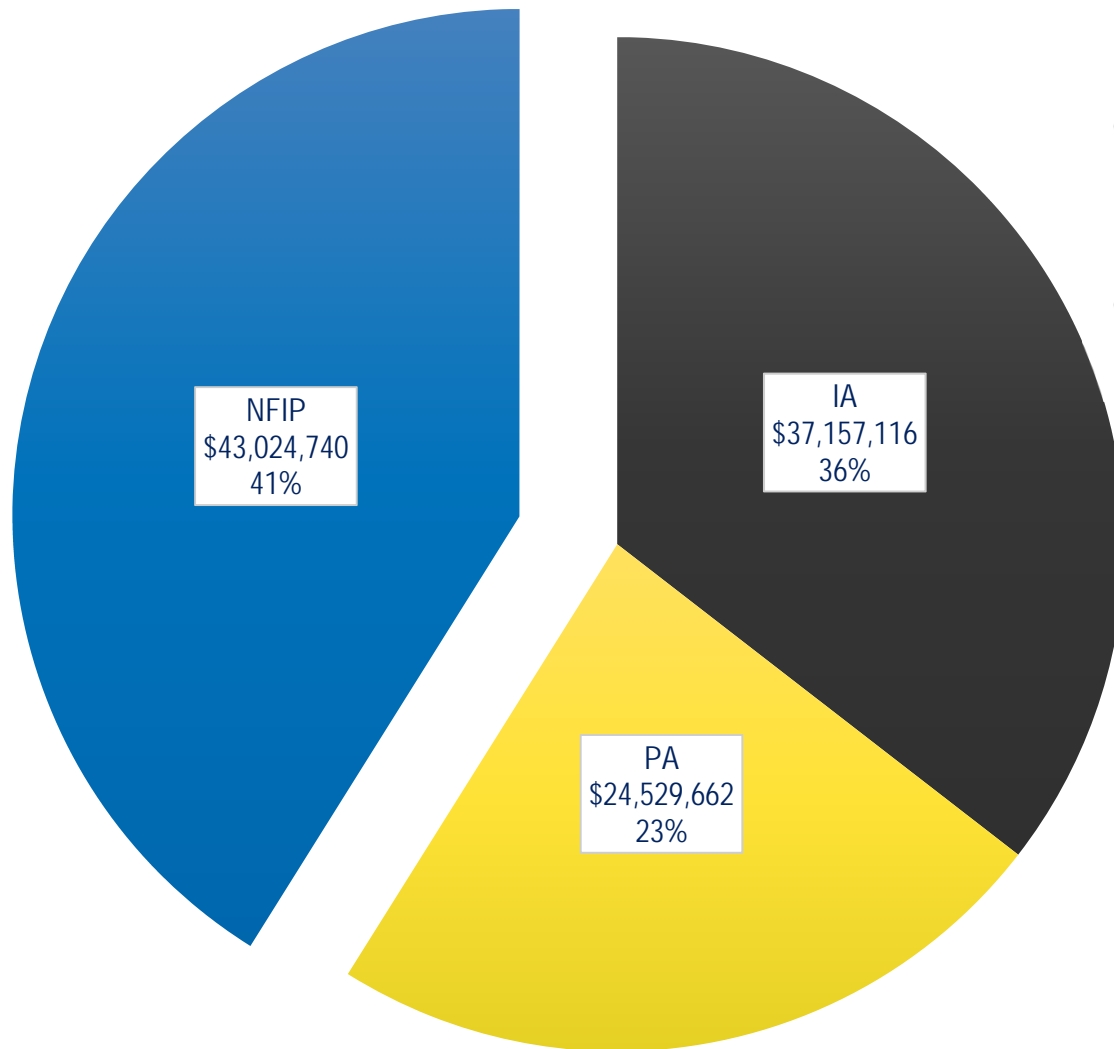

Section 1206 of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act authorizes FEMA to provide assistance to state and local governments for building code and floodplain management ordinance administration and enforcement via Stafford Act authorities.
